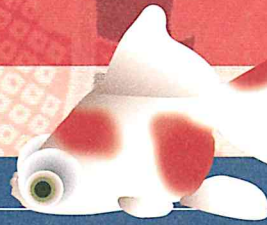
# 2017

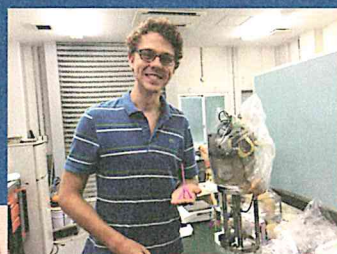
