This project seeks to develop a thorough understanding of the factors that influence information processing and decision-making in multiple stakeholder groups working on complex, ambiguous, and societally relevant topics. In particular, the project aims at developing means to optimize information processing and to facilitate decision-making processes by management teams.

Responsibilities: As a junior researcher and doctoral candidate, you will...

- contribute to theory development based on a thorough literature review, case studies, and expert interviews
- design and conduct empirical research to test interventions to enhance group decision-making
- present project results at leading international conferences and write papers for publication in high-impact journals
- participate in project meetings and assist in project management

Requirements:

Successful applicants should have completed prior research and training in areas related to this project, (e.g. team work, leadership) and have an outstanding academic record in (organizational, social, or cognitive) psychology or a related discipline. Advanced knowledge of empirical research methods with a focus on experimental designs is necessary for this position. The successful candidate should have excellent German and English language skills and be highly motivated to work in an interdisciplinary research group.
