

PhD Position in General Psychology, 65 % T-VL

A PhD position for 3 years (No. 4-14570/19-D) is advertised at the Martin-Luther University Halle-Wittenberg, Institute of Psychology, the research unit General Psychology. The position is located in a research project of the priority program Multitasking (DFG) and includes the participation in a well-organized PhD and post-doc program.

Requirements:

- Finished courses in Psychology (Diploma or MSc) or in related subjects such as Cognitive Science, Biology, Informatics, etc.
- Good knowledge and skills in the cognitive psychology, for example in fields like action control, attention, working memory or others; interest in psychological research with a research perspective in cognitive neuroscience.

Tasks:
