

## **Ph.D. position (3 years, 65% E13 TV-L) available at the University of Würzburg**

We are seeking applicants for a PhD position within the newly established Motivation and Emotion in Action Lab at the Department of Psychology, University of Würzburg (PI: Andreas Eder). The position is part of a research grant awarded to Andreas Eder by the DFG ([Ed201/7-1](#)). The aim of the project is to investigate feedback processes regulating aggressive interactions between people. The successful candidate will work closely with a research team dedicated to the study of motivation and emotion. She or he will conduct various behavioral experiments and will be expected to present the findings at international conferences and in peer-reviewed publications. A PhD thesis should be completed within the duration of the project on a topic related to motivation and emotion.

Requirements: Applicants should have a Master's or equivalent degree in psychology, cognitive neuroscience, or a related field and should have a high affinity with/good skills in conducting and analyzing experimental studies. Experience with experiment programming is desired. Applicants should have a strong dedication to a scientific career, good oral and written skills in English, and some knowledge of German (or the willingness to learn German quickly). The University of Würzburg is strongly committed to diversity within its community and especially welcomes applications from members of underrepresented groups.

Benefits: The successful candidate will be a member in a stimulating research group working at the intersection of cognitive, social, and affective sciences. She or he will benefit from a rich interdisciplinary research environment at the Faculty of Human Sciences with an affiliated graduate school. The PhD position is financed for 3 years and payment is according to 65% E 13 TV-L (see [online calculator](#)).
